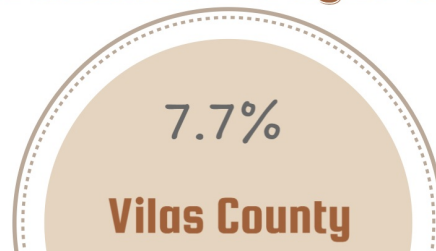
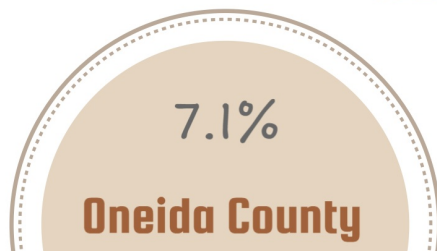
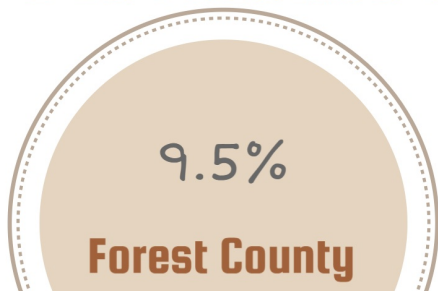


Chronic Disease Prevention & Management

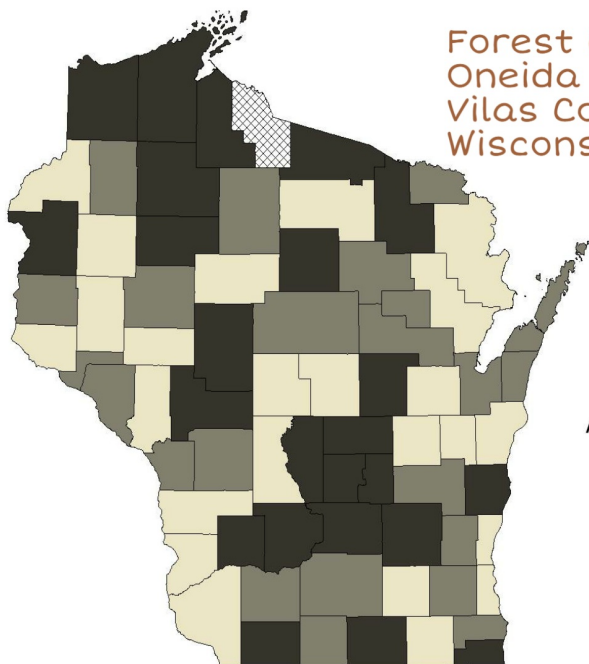
Currently, seven of the ten leading causes of death in Wisconsin and the United States as a whole, are due to chronic diseases, accounting for approximately 2 out of every 3 deaths annually. In addition, over 80 percent of the \$2 trillion spent on health care in the United States each year goes toward treatment of chronic diseases.
