COVID-19 Vaccines Available for Individuals without Insurance at Oneida County Health Department

Oneida County Health Department (OCHD) is excited to introduce the Bridge Access Program that provides no-cost COVID-19 vaccines to adults without health insurance and adults whose insurance does not cover all COVID-19 vaccine costs. This program is dedicated to ensuring that everyone in our community has access to COVID-19 vaccines.

Key Information on the Bridge Access Program and eligibility:

- ✓ Eligibility: The Bridge Program offers COVID-19 vaccines at no cost to adults 18 years and older who do not have health insurance and adults whose insurance does not provide zero-cost access to COVID-19 vaccines.
- ✓ **Non-Discrimination:** The Bridge Access Program will provide no-cost COVID-19 vaccines to all eligible adults through December 31, 2024.

OCHD encourages all eligible adults, particularly those without insurance or whose insurance does not provide zero-cost access to COVID-19 vaccines, to explore the benefits of the Bridge Access Program and get their COVID-19 vaccine.
