Provide an approved locked storage area to store all medications that are required to be surrendered to camp health service staff by campers and staff under 18 years of age. Correct By: 29-Jun-2022</p> <p><b>CODE CITATION:</b> ATCP 78.19(6)(b) Except as allowed in par. (c), all medication brought to camp by a camper or staff member under 18 years of age shall be kept in a locked unit and shall be administered by health services staff qualified under sub. (5) (b), except that bee sting medication, inhalers, an insulin syringe or other medication or device used in the event of life threatening situations may be carried by a camper or staff member. Each camper or staff member 18 years of age or older may take responsibility for the security of his or her personal medication.</p> <p><b>OBSERVATION:</b> No smoke detector in nurse's sleeping room in health center.</p> <p><b>CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):</b> Install a smoke detector in every sleeping room.
