Good Retail Practices - 48 - Warewashing facilities: installed, maintained, & used: test strips

OBSERVATION: No thermo labels provided to check final surface temperature of high temperature dishwash machine. **CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Provide thermo labels. Warewashing machine shall be equipped with a temperature measuring device that measures the temperature of water in the wash and rinse tank, the incoming water for hot water sanitizing or water in the chemical sanitizing tank Correct By: 28-Jun-2022

CODE CITATION: 4-204.115 A WAREWASHING machine shall be equipped with a TEMPERATURE MEASURING

DEVICE that indicates the temperature of the water:

- (A) In each wash and rinse tank; [Pf] and
- (B) As the water enters the hot water SANITIZING final rinse manifold or in the chemical SANITIZING solution tank. [Pf]

Risk/Intervention - 28 - Toxic substances properly identified, stored and used; held for retail sale, properly stored This is a Critical violation

OBSERVATION: Quat sanitizer level for sanitizer bucket above 400ppm.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Use mounted quat sanitizer provided by compartment sinks to fill wiping cloth sanitizer buckets. Sanitizer concentration level should be 250-400ppm or per manufacturer instructions. Sanitizer shall meet the requirements under 40 CFR 180.940 or 40 CFR 180.2020. Correct By: 28-Jun-2022

CODE CITATION: 7-204.11 Chemical SANITIZERS, including chemical sanitizing solutions generated on-site, and other chemical antimicrobials applied to FOOD-CONTACT SURFACES shall:

- (A) Meet the requirements specified in 40 CFR 180.940 Tolerance exemptions for active and inert ingredients for use in antimicrobial formulations (FOOD-CONTACT SURFACE SANITIZING solutions) [P], or
- (B) Meet the requirements as specified in 40 CFR 180.2020 Pesticide Chemicals Not Requiring a Tolerance or Exemption from Tolerance-Non-food determinations. [P]

OBSERVATION: Unused archery equipment is not stored securely. Bows and arrows are left out when staff went to lunch and rest time.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Secure and lock all archery equipment when not in use Correct By: 28-Jun-2022 **CODE CITATION:** ATCP 78.18(3) (c) No firearms or archery equipment are permitted in a camp except for use in an organized and supervised camp activity. All firearms, ammunition and archery equipment not being used shall be securely stored under lock.
